city - a city has a cathedral or a university, a form of local government. It has a large population.

county - a geographical region of a country.

country - A nation with its own government, occupying a particular territory.

population - a group of people living in a given geographical area.

human geographical feature - has been built or put there by humans.

physical geographical feature - has always been there. It is part of nature.

aerial view - any view from a great height, even at a wide angle

ocean - a very large expanse of water

continent - A continent is a massive area of land that is separated from others by water or other natural features.

Hemisphere - half of the globe/The Plant Earth

weather - January is the coolest month in Leeds. July is the hottest month.

Cape Town

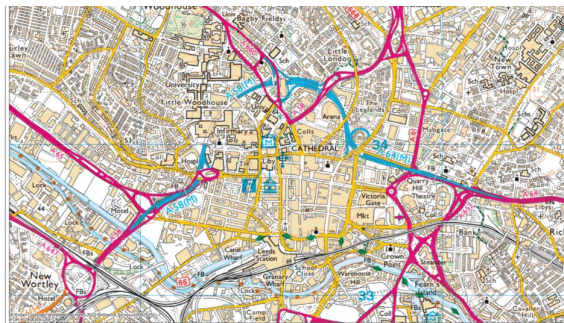
Cape Town is in West Cape in South Africa. South Africa is in Africa.
