


**Aerial photograph**




**Aerial plan**



**Things to talk about at home.**

Drawing simple maps with symbols. Using symbols in a key to represent where features are.



Maps are 2-D drawings of our world from above or a bird’s eye view. They help us find our way around and show where different places are in relation to each other (**distance** and **directions**).



To know simple compass directions and describe where things are according to the direction.

To know the human and physical features of our local area.

In Pudsey there is Pudsey Park, Pudsey Parish Church, Pudsey Leisure Centre, Pudsey Cenotaph, library and bus station.

The physical features of Pudsey are Pudsey Park, Black Carr Woods and Tyersal Beck.

The human features of Pudsey are the schools, shops, bus station, train station and churches.
