Nursery Police Visits

Nursery were visited by the police this week and have enjoyed finding out about how the police help us. They had the opportunity to ask questions, dress up in uniform, and sit inside a real police car! Lots of the children would now like to be police officers when they grow up!

Y2 Sustainability Workshop

Year 2 were visited by Mika and Liz from Leeds Beckett University and delivered a workshop to them all about sustainability. Children were introduced

to what an ecosystem is and how different each of them are. After learning about the ecosystems, children were shown an axolotl, a cuatro ciénegas softshell turtle and monarch butterflies and learnt about how they are at risk. They learnt about how we can protect them by making small changes in our daily life, like taking shorter showers and recycling.



Y3 Leeds City Museum Trip

Year 3 visited Leeds City Museum earlier this week to learn all about life in Ancient Egypt. Both classes took part in a fun workshop where they could learn and perform the steps for mummification using a dummy, and decide which canopic jars to put the organs in! Later, they had a guided tour around the Ancient Worlds exhibit, finding artefacts such as an Egyptian death mask, amulets and most interesting of all, a real mummy! We were so impressed with all their historical knowledge and thoughtful questions during the trip. Well done Year 3!



Y4 Leeds Industrial Museum

Year 4 had a fabulous visit to Leeds Industrial Museum last week. Children experienced what it was like to be a child and work in the mill. We were lucky enough to see one of the woollen machines working and then we had a tour of a replica Victorian house. Following that, children visited the school room. They impressed the school master with their outstanding arithmetic, their strength when lifting the dumbbells and their elegant handwriting. As always, the children's behaviour was excellent - they represented Pudsey Waterloo so well. Thank you to our volunteers who came along to make the trip possible.



Y6 Library Trip

This week both Year 6 classes enjoyed a fantastic visit to Pudsey Library, where they dove headfirst into an interactive LEGO workshop. The children represented the school beautifully, working in pairs to tackle some truly impressive engineering challenges. Combining creativity with cutting-edge technology, they built intricate models, including fully functioning helicopters, and learned how to code them so the propellers would spin and make noise! It was wonderful to see their teamwork and digital skills come to life, and we are incredibly proud of how well they collaborated throughout the day!



Y6 Sustainability Workshop

Year 6 had a visit from two Leeds University graduate students this week, who delivered a session on renewable energy. They engaged in a discussion about the different types of renewable energy and then the children made models of buildings from lego and showed how they could be connected to renewable energy sources.
